**Colorado's Own "Wine Doctor" Swears Under Oath, His
Wine Does NOT Contain Any Illegal Stimulants,
Even Though It Was Once Outlawed In Canada**

Can it be possible a wine is so well-liked, the government steps in and develops an entire department of regulation, just to monitor its production and distribution?

You wouldn't think so, but that's exactly what happened to Lino DiFelice, affectionately know as "The Wine Doctor" by his customers.

DiFelice owns Vintages, America's first "Micro-Winery". At Vintages, you buy special wine-grapes and then custom-make your own wines to suit your taste.

You do everything, from top-to-bottom, under DiFelice's guidance. You can even put your own personal labels on the bottle if you'd like.

Lino says "I started this business in Canada in 1982, and when we opened, we were the only one's doing this."

"We were buying grapes from all over the world based on our customer's personal tastes, fermenting them, and then bottling the finished wine using the inside secrets passed down to me directly from the old-school wine cellar-masters in my family's hometown in South Central Italy."

"What happened was, people were craving the freshness of the wine (DiFelice's wine is made with no preservatives in it) and our wine became all the rage in my hometown in Ontario."

"Then, out of nowhere, the government stepped in and started regulating things because the word about our wine was spreading like wildfire."

Apparently though, making wine at home has been a tradition in DiFelice's family for generations, and in fact, findings from archaeological digs show wine being made as early as 5400 B.C.

Now there are a handful of other competitors in Canada, where spirits are heavily taxed, but Vintages is the first retail store of its kind here in America.
